Our Organization:

Centre for Inclusive Development Charitable Trust came into existence with the initiative taken up by a group of few young activists from different parts of West Bengal, India, who wanted to address the social issues, e.g., Child Rights, Gender Rights, Environment, Education, Health and other basic social issues with pro-active initiatives.

After several years of work in association with a few local organizations in the fields of Child education and women's economic self-sufficiency we are finally in a process of steady development. After many years of tireless effort, now our organization is running a school for the children of the migrant workers, working in the brick-fields of Nadia district in West Bengal, India. We can proudly say that, now we are serving at least 500 beneficiaries every year within our limited financial capacity. We are trying pro-actively to increase the number of these beneficiaries every year.

After almost 4 years of work only with crowd funding, we finally decided to become a charitable trust in 2023 to work in a more structured and efficient way. Due to our already established credibility in the field of social work, right after we got registered, the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) of Cooch Behar District invited us to organize a program at Swadhar Greh Home at Baneshwar, Cooch Behar. In that program, we provided 31 beneficiaries with new cloths in the occasion of the Festive Season.

Our Goal:

Our primary goal is to play our part in the creation of a just and equitable society where everyone in the world can live and realize their potential to the fullest. The world we are living in today is plagued with multiple social inequalities. The United Nations has declared 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) to fight these social inequalities. We are working on the ground to realize these 17 Goals. We also want to expand our field of work into the territory of interdisciplinary research in due course as we believe that a sound theoretical basis is necessary for the true development of the society.

The overview of the project:

The problems the migrant workers face in India, is not limited to the adversities they face in their work-place. From a humanitarian perspective, we can safely assume that, in our country most of them travel to complete alien places in search of better livelihood and are forced to settle down without any sort of social security. The lack of infrastructure means that those families spend their lives without the very basic necessities, i.e., proper housing, sanitation, health and education.

This is a general overview of the lives of the families of migrant workers. Now we will shift our focus to the area where we have been working.

In the district of Nadia in West Bengal, India, there are at least 155 documented and several other unregistered brickfields along the 'Jalangi' River. These brick fields draw a huge number of migrants

to saturate the vacancy of workers. These people usually migrate along with their families from other parts of India. The minors residing there, enjoy a miniscule degree of opportunities to have a proper childhood.

To solve the situation, we have taken up an initiative of running a school for these children. The school is not only taking care of their basic education, but also their very basic healthcare and nutritional requirements. We have been running this initiative solely based on crowd-funding up and till now. Under this project, we have served at least 500 beneficiaries annually.

From 2016, the school commenced their journey with a few children of the migrant workers working in the 'Shanti Brick Field', located near Ghurni area of Krishnanagar in Nadia district. With restrained funds we have tried our best to provide for the children with basic education, healthcare and proper nutritional food. There is a dedicated set of 5 teacher who are regularly tending to the students. We have also provided the students with books, pens and other necessary stationaries for the last five years. Not only education, we have also tried within our limited capacity to provide the very basic nutrition and healthcare to these children over a prolonged period of time. We have also formulated a government sanctioned school code to run the process smooth.

With our project scaling up to sustain these beneficiaries, we will be needing your support to move forward.
