



## In a nutshell..

We are happy to let you know that, this month our organization has consolidated its field of work a little more. Though we are young, we are glad to say that we are undertaking three ambitious projects right now, solely based on crowdfunding. As we have mentioned in the previous newsletter, our work on Education in the brickfields of Nadia has consolidated further. We have successfully completed the first month of our school, "Barna Parichay Primary School". With the help of three teachers and one non-teaching staff we are now serving a 100 families with basic education and nutrition.



## Our Achievement

We're delighted to share that Chandmani Sarkar (Name Changed) has been safely rescued and returned to her family in Jhaukuthi village of Cooch Behar. On March 7, 2024, Nilchand Sarkar's underage daughter was abducted and unlawfully detained by Mukshad Ali Sarkar, who has been harassing her with various ill intentions since long.

Despite efforts from the local Panchayat and other respected individuals to negotiate with the accused and his family, they returned empty-handed. Four days later, on March 11, 2024, the minor girl's father filed a formal complaint with the Tufanganj police station. By March 17, 2024, the family sought assistance from CIDC Trust through Bakir Hossain, one of our organization's volunteers. On the same day, we promptly relayed the case details to West Bengal Commission for Protection of Child Rights (WBCPCR) and various governmental and international entities dealing with child trafficking. Fortunately, WBCPCR took swift and serious action, demonstrating a positive attitude toward rescuing the child, which proved effective.

A big thanks to the WBCPCR office for their dedicated efforts. We also commend the Tufanganj police for their role in this successful rescue mission. Each and every member of the CIDC Trust has played an indispensable role in this rescue mission.
